Accessing the DARS SharePoint Site


The DARS SharePoint site is housed under ASA Connect which is a part of the SharePoint Application. This is available for you to use as a place to find documentation, conference information, training information, etc. that used to be housed on the external Minnesota State webpage.

This document is to provide you with step-by-step instructions for accessing the DARS SharePoint site **for the first time**. After you log in for the first time, you can bookmark the areas that you visit the most.

- Log in to ASA Connect homepage https://mnscu.sharepoint.com/sites/asa/SitePages/home.aspx
- 2. Enter login name: yourstarid@minnstate.edu
- 3. Enter password: your StarID password
- 4. Once you are logged in, click on 'ASA Topics'




5. Select 'DARS' to access the DARS SharePoint site.


7. Please explore the site! The best way to get familiar is to click around on the different links. The goal is to create a platform where users can find the documentation and information that they need all in one spot.


Accessing the DARS Help Desk




'Resources'

Resources (on the right hand side of the main DARS SharePoint site) is where all of our documentation lives. Think of 'Resources' as 'Documents.'






Or, if you prefer, we have added a link to 'Resources' on the main page under 'Support and Documentation.'







Quick Access to Other Related SharePoint Sites


From the DARS SharePoint site, click on any of the icons under 'Other Related Topics.'
