### SHAKESPEARE WITH POWER TOOLS AND BEYOND

#### **BACKGROUND**

The Academic and Student Affairs Committee periodically sets aside time during its meeting to gain insights and discuss in greater depth a topic with broad policy implications.

This month the committee has invited two recently retired, long-term college presidents to share their insights about the role of the two-year college in preparing students for the future workforce.
