# Web tool to search for offerings system-wide

Approach: Make website available to prospective students.

Project functionality will be released in June, 2011 with high confidence.

Campus administrative tool will be user tested with institutions, available in May, 2011.

Other data sources including ISRS and DARS are being built into a central data source.

#### Items of note:

- There will be a redesign of the system website.
- MnOnline will be embedded in the website.

# Search services available for use on campus websites

Approach: Provide institutions with optional tools to utilize functionality of Single Search.

Project functionality will be released in June, 2011 with high confidence.

Full implementation will be on a rolling basis.



#### **E-Transcripts for transfer students**

Completed November, 2009

- E-transcripts are a transfer related improvement.
- This project has been very well received by students and campuses.

#### **Communications Module (paper based)**

Approach: Replace current communication functionality with webbased functionality. Paper correspondence is the first phase.

The module was piloted during November of 2010.

It was determined by pilot campuses that the text editor needed replacement.

The revised software was released March 11th, 2011.

#### Item of note:

 The Communications Module is currently used for prospective, applicant, and admitted students, and will be expanded to other areas of ISRS (e.g. financial aid).



#### **Email for Communications Module**

Approach: In addition to paper correspondence, provide institutions the ability to communicate via email.

Email functionality will be released in June, 2011 with high confidence.

# **Text messaging for Communications Module**

Approach: In addition to paper correspondence, provide institutions the ability to communicate via text messaging

Text messaging functionality will be released in September with medium confidence because both the vendor and technology are new to our system. In addition, there is a freeze on releasing new functionality from mid August through mid September.



# Web Single Application for multiple institutions

Approach: Replace current web application with new version

Project functionality will be released in June 2011 with high confidence.

15 students performed an informal usability test in early March; formal usability testing will occur in late April.

#### Item of note:

• Single application will be integrated from Single Search to the Payment module.

# Improve login process for online applications

Approach: Replace current login process with new version

Project functionality will be released in June, 2011 with high confidence.

#### Items of note:

- This project enables the student to seamlessly move around our system and apply for admissions without re-entering basic application data.
- The login process for online applications has been simplified.
- Star ID will replace the admissions application login id and student id in the next iteration.



#### **Graduation Planner**

Approach: Install software, build roadmaps, and validate.

Early experimental roadmap activity April-June, 2011

Software receipt and validation July, 2011
Assessment August, 2011

Early adopter implementation TBD

The vendor has provided a delivery date of June 30, 2011. Due to a large number of unknowns, overall confidence is low.

#### Item of note:

 The assessment will address topics such as resources, the impact on advising, setup methods, and future course mapping.

#### **Waitlist with email Communication**

Completed February, 2010

- The student experience has been very positive.
- Institutions are refining how it is implemented.



# Improve searches for courses shared by institutions

Completed February, 2010

- Student transcripts are clearer.
- Duplicate manual data entry is eliminated.
- Shared course student registration is simplified.

# Search for equivalent courses at other institutions

Completed in November, 2010

#### Items of note:

- Students are able to register across institutions.
- For most students, this is Single Registration.



# Improve registration for courses at multiple institutions

Approach: Re-write registration edits to support new board policy on system wide financial and academic holds, and other registration edits.

Project functionality will be released in July, 2011 *with medium confidence*.

#### Item of note:

Most of the registration edits are institution facing.

#### **Realtime Web grading**

Approach: Replace the old web grading system with an enhanced version.

Project functionality was released in March, 2011.

Over the next several months we will monitor the functionality for user issues.

#### Item of note:

Last date of attendance functionality will provide institutions improved financial aid compliance.



# Waitlist communication enhanced text messaging

Approach: Add text messaging to waitlist communication.

Project functionality will be released in September, 2011 with medium confidence.

#### Item of note:

 This project is dependent on text messaging being available for the Communication module.

# Stronger Passwords to better protect student data

Completed November, 2009

- Students are required to change password regularly.
- Password rules are more complex (e.g. minimum 8 characters).



#### Single Billing/Single Payment

Approach: Replace current student payment functionality with ability to pay across institutions.

Project functionality is complete and is currently rolling out to a pilot institution.

Project functionality will incrementally roll out to institutions beginning in September, 2011 with medium confidence because resources are cross-allocated with SWIFT.

#### Item of note:

Discussion of common payment and registration cancellation framework is balancing institutional differences with a consistent student experience.

#### W-2 and 1098 tax forms: opt in

Approach: Create web-based checkbox for student to opt in the tax forms for 2011 tax year

Opt in functionality will be released in September with medium confidence because resources are cross-allocated with SWIFT.

#### Item of note:

 The second phase of this project is to have the tax forms available to students on the web in January



#### Student initiated duplicate records merge

#### Completed April 2010

- Duplicate student records in ISRS are incrementally reduced.
- The functionality empowers students to resolve their own duplicate records.
- Duplicate student records will always be work in progress in an integrated system.

# **Student Loan Acceptance** and Certification

Approach: Automate an existing manual process.

Student loan acceptance and form field auto-population will be piloted in April, 2011 *with high confidence*.

Student loan acceptance and form field auto-population will be released to all campuses in May, 2011 with high confidence.

Loan approval will be released in June, 2011 with high confidence.

#### Items of note:

- The timeline will work well for students and financial aid offices as Fall Semester approaches.
- Both phases will significantly reduce back office work.
