## Residential Life Strategy

- Residential life master plan
- Gage Hall off line in Fall 2012
- Gap in on-campus capacity
- Short term solution (year to year)
- Approximately 250 beds

#### **Lease Terms**

Start Date: August 1, 2012

End Date: July 31, 2013 (with 4 x 1 year options to

extend the term)

Units: 84 - 3 bedroom apartments

Beds: 252 bedrooms

Rent: \$1,372,800/year for years 1-3

\$1,413,984/year for years 4-5

Total Rent: \$6.9 million for all 5 years

Furnishings: University to provide (similar to res hall room)





## **Opportunity**

- Improve Underutilized Space
  - Receiving area
  - No academic program
  - Wing could be better utilized
- Community Partnerships
  - Hormel Foundation
  - Identified community need for early childhood care and education
- Alternative capital financing model



## **Project Proposal**

- \$3 million renovation cost
- Capital Financing
  - \$2 million committed by Hormel Foundation
  - \$1 million plus from Hormel Foundation partners
  - Enter into construction agreement
- Design/Schedule
  - Hormel Foundation to fund design and manage construction
  - Meet MnSCU design standards
  - Pending Board approval, finalize design



## **Project / User**

- Day care
  - Request for Proposal
  - Financially viability
  - Lease agreement
  - User would pay operating costs
- Potential for college program tie-in
- Change/end of use

### **National Hockey & Events Center**

### Original Plan

- Two Phases
- Phase I \$13.8 million project cost
  - \$6.5 million general obligation bonds
  - \$7.3 million from university foundation
- Phase II \$15.4 million
  - Fully funded from foundation/capital campaign
- Total expected project costs both phases
  - \$29.2 million

#### Original Board Action

March 2010



## **Change in Project Financing**

- Phase I only
- Financing plan changed
  - Limits on use of general obligation bonds
  - Foundation agreement revisions
- Result
  - Phase I financing needed rework
  - Alternative financing mechanism needed
  - General obligation bond authority left unused



## **Revised Financing**

- Change to Phase I project only
- Add Phase I to the Revenue Fund
- Use \$3 million in taxable revenue bond proceeds
- Use up to \$2.2 million from St. Cloud's residential life reserves
- Foundation to supply remaining balance needed for Phase I




#### **Recommended Motion**

The Board hereby adds the Phase I National Hockey and Events
Center as identified on **Attachment A** to the revenue fund, and

- a) Authorizes the use of up to \$3 million of taxable bond proceeds available from the 2009 and/or 2011 revenue bond sales and related university contributions as described herein to complete Phase I work, and
- b) All other terms and conditions of the Board's original action in March 2010 are continuing including the St. Cloud State University Foundation financial commitment to providing the remainder of funding necessary for the completion of the Phase I project in the National Hockey and Events Center.




