### Joint Powers Overview - SMSU

- Supervisory Committee to manage a relationship between SMSU and the Marshall Public School District (Independent School District #413)
- Subject: \$2.88 million upgrade to former Mattke Field
  - Partner with school district
  - Approximately 1/2 paid back through 10 year lease with school district
  - Mostly hardscape and turf surfaces
  - Small equipment building
- Lease agreement with the school district



# Joint Powers Agreement


- Facility:
  - Owned and operated by SMSU
- Governance:
  - Supervisory Management Committee
  - Operations, Scheduling, & Maintenance Committee
  - Agreement includes scheduling priorities
- Funding:
  - SMSU Operating Funds / ISD 413 Lease Levy
  - Lease with SMSU over a 10 year period at 2% interest
  - Rental income and a percent of gate income:
    - Capital Contingency and O&M Funds
  - Costs shared, reevaluated annually

### Recommendation

# Revenue Bond Refinancing - ICC

#### Gain Board of Trustees approval for:

- 1. Itasca County HRA to issue refunding bonds to refinance tax exempt bonds originally issued in 2004 by the HRA for the construction of Itasca Residence Hall, and
- 2. Grant the chancellor or his designee authority to execute any necessary documents

**Note:** The college's revenues (housing, cafeteria and bookstore) are the sole pledge for repayment of the bonds.





# Comparisons

Original Financing (2004)

Par Amount: \$2,640,000

• Ave. Rate: 5.7%

Proposed Refunding (2013)

Par Amount: \$1,975,000

■ True Interest Cost: 3.5%

Estimated annual savings: \$34,000

Remaining term: 13 years
