Failure to comply with the aforementioned may result in civil or criminal penalties.

Submittal

The Contractor is solely responsible for payment of all required Prevailing Wage Rates. Further, the Owner will not be liable for increased labor cost, errors in the rates or classifications, or changes to same prior to or after the award of Contracts. The Contractor and all Subcontractors shall furnish to the contracting agency, copies of any or all payrolls **not more than 14 days after the end of each pay period**. The payrolls must contain all the data required by Minnesota Statutes Section 177.30.

The use of Minnesota State Form 073, Part 1 Prevailing Wage Payroll Information and Part 2 Statement of Compliance, is MANDATORY. This is a two part form and is made available for the convenience of Contractors and Subcontractors who are required to submit prevailing wage payroll information (see sample forms attached). These forms can be found and downloaded at: Minnesota State - eManual Version 2.0 for Vendors, under Project Phases, Construction (CO), CO.23 and CO.24.
