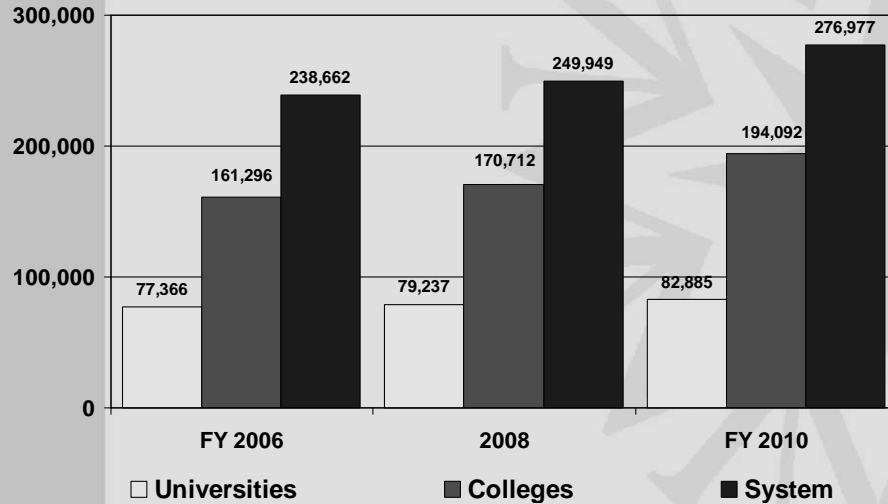

Figure 1: Credit Headcount Enrollment Fiscal Years 2006 to 2010 and Fall 2009 to 2010

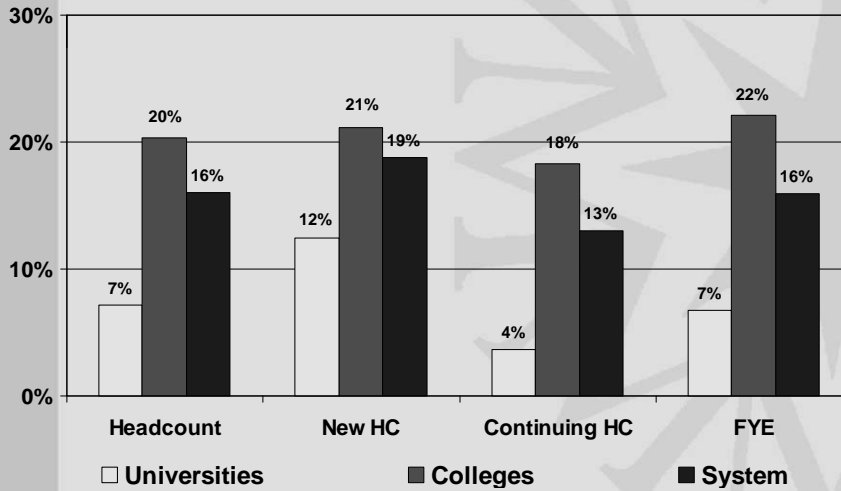

Figure 2: Change in Headcount, New & Continuing Students and FYE Enrollment FY 2006 to FY 2010

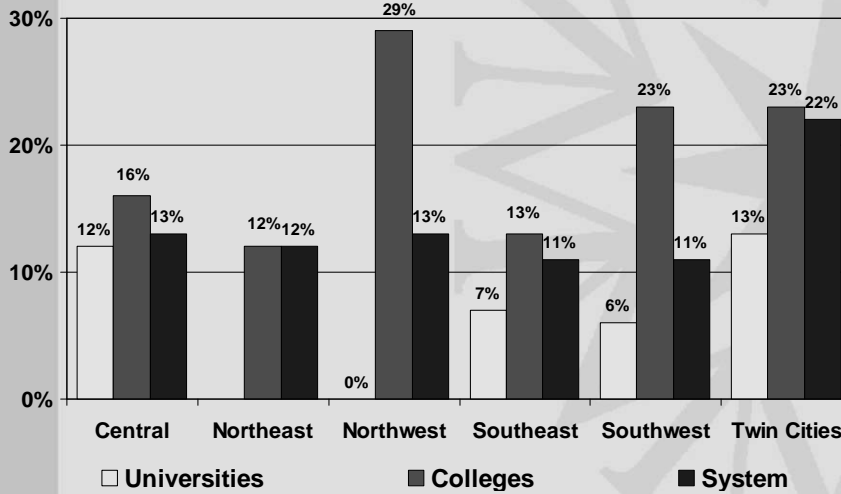

Figure 3: Change in Credit Headcount by College & University Region FY 2006 to FY 2010

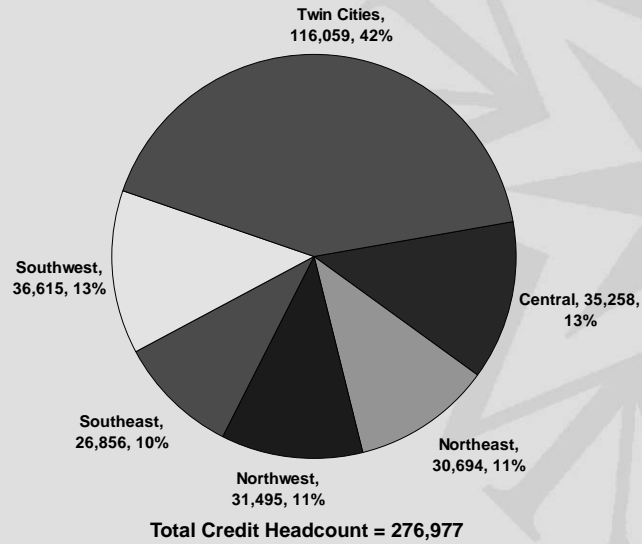

Figure 4: Credit Headcount by College & University Region Fiscal Year 2010

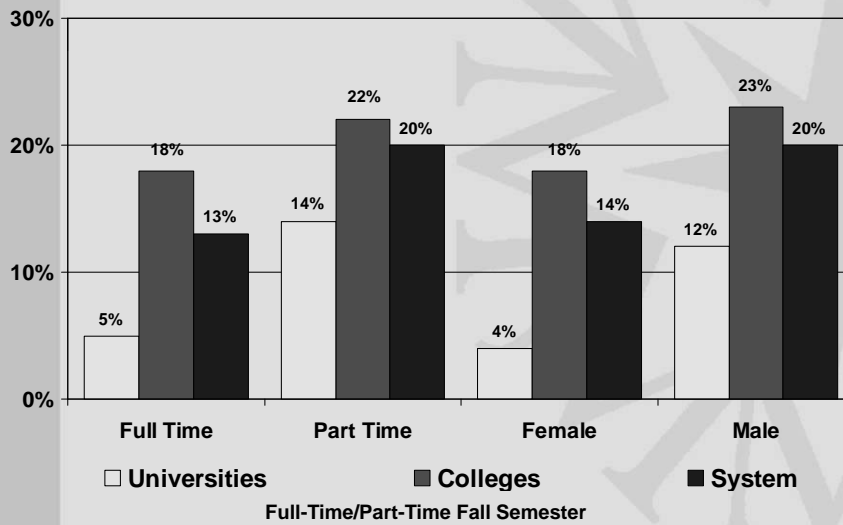

Figure 5: Change in Credit Headcount by Credit Load and Gender FY 2006 to FY 2010

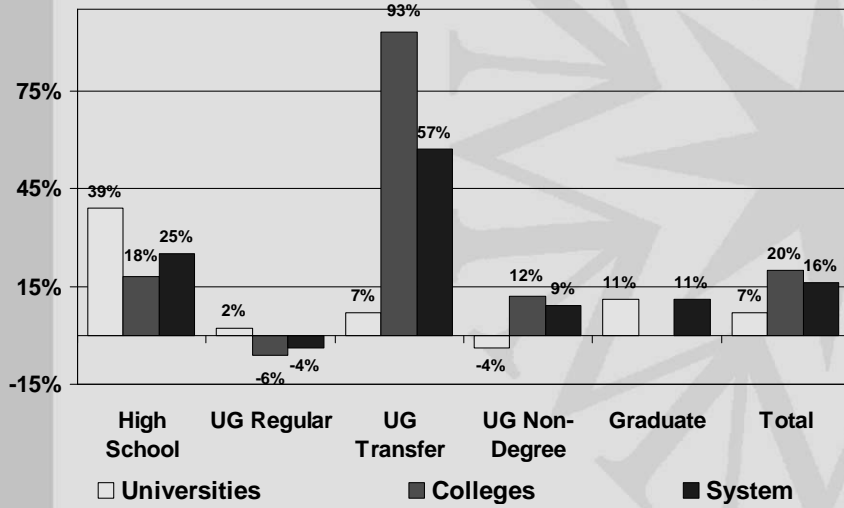

Figure 6: Change in Headcount by Admission Status Fiscal Years 2006 to 2010

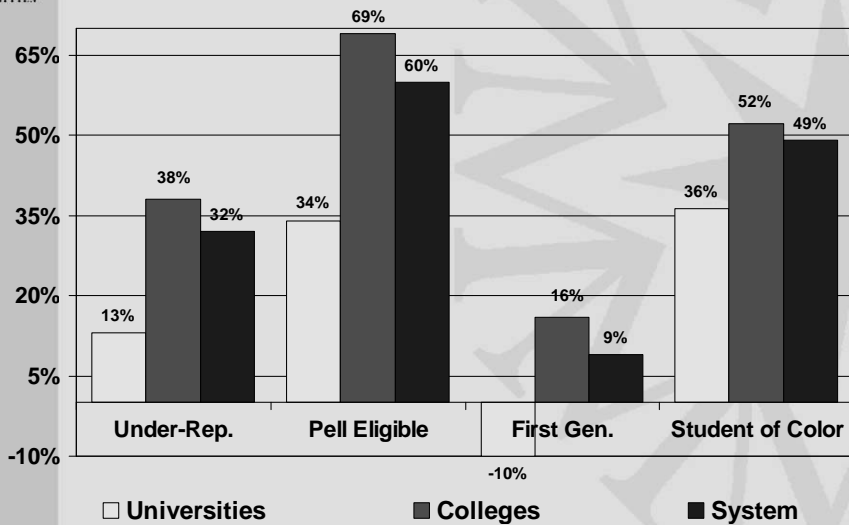

Figure 7: Change in Headcount by Underrepresented Category Fiscal Years 2006 to 2010

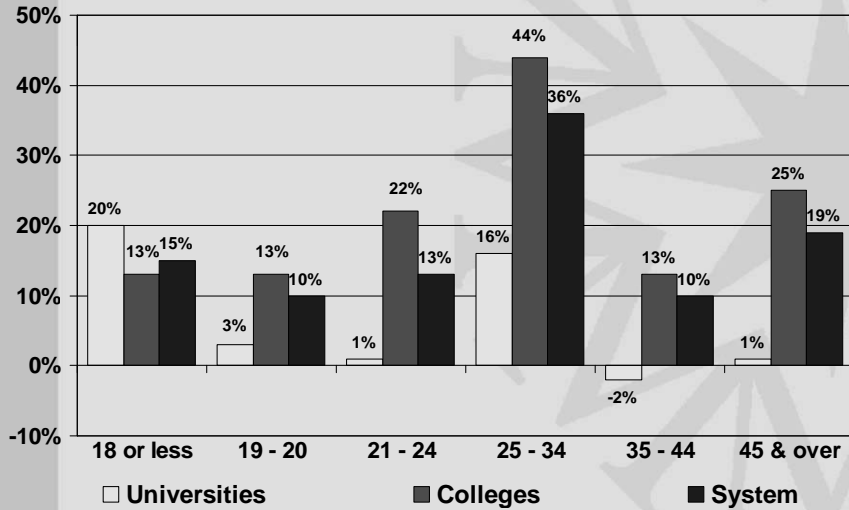

Figure 8: Change in Headcount by Age Category Fiscal Years 2006 to 2010

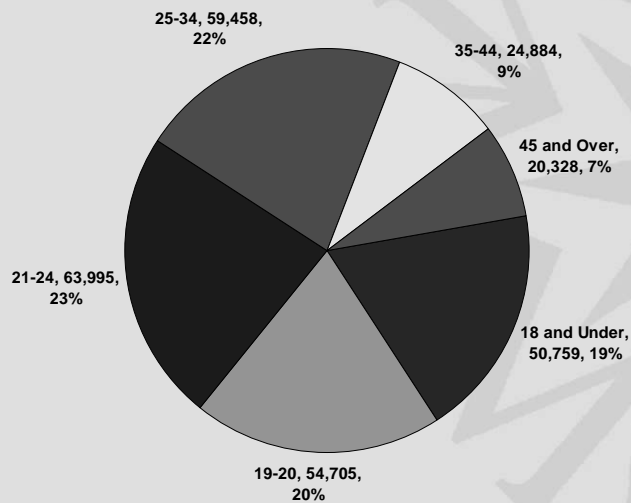

Figure 9: Credit Headcount by Age Category Fiscal Year 2010



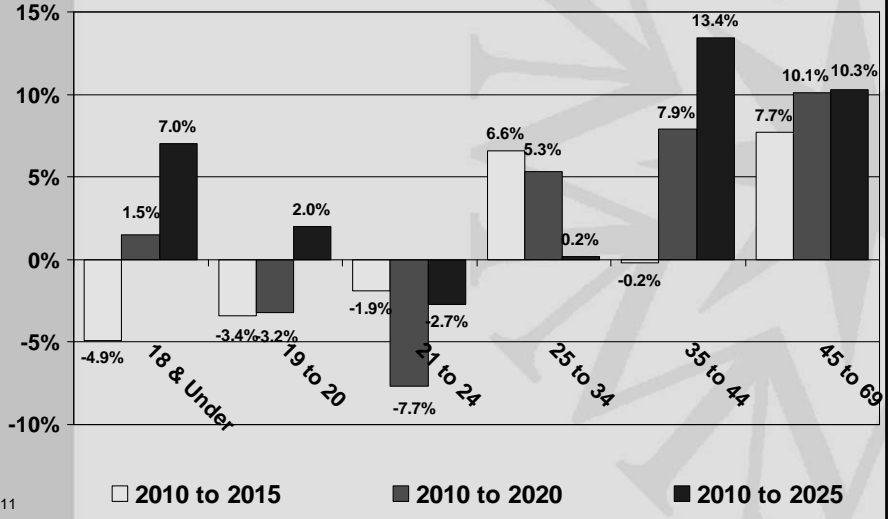
